Haoma Mining Shareholder Update

Elazac Process Update on Test Work at Bamboo Creek

Haoma Shareholders were advised on July 4, 2024, that the ALS Laboratory Perth had measured 6.8g/t gold in aqua regia solution produced by Elazac Process Test Work on Kitchener Mine low gold grade dump ore, which traditional assays measured 0.5g/t gold.

On July 4, 2024, Shareholders were advised Elazac Process tests were conducted without smelting ore samples and without the use of any cyanide.

Shareholders were also advised that KordaMentha had been appointed as Receivers and Managers to Calidus Resources Limited (ASX: CAI).

On July 10, 2024, KordaMentha advised Calidus Shareholders that the Calidus Processing Plant at Warrawoona would cease production and be transitioned into care and maintenance over a period of approximately 3 weeks.

Haoma owns 100% of the tailings produced by Calidus at the Warrawoona Processing Plant, today about 4 million tonnes which by traditional assay methods measure <0.1g/t gold.

Haoma has conducted many tests on Calidus Tails using the Elazac Process, up until this report all gold grade readings by aqua regia measured less than 0.3g/t gold.

Over the last week, Elazac Process Test Work produced gold bullion from Calidus Tails which resulted in a calculated gold grade of 1.42g/t in Calidus Tails.

The first stage of recovering **1.42g/t gold from the 4 million tonnes** of Calidus Tails (July 17, 2024, value \$650+m) could be immediately achieved by reprocessing the Tails using the existing Calidus Processing Plant at Warrawoona:

- without the use of cyanide, and
- only 'small', inexpensive changes, to the existing Calidus Processing Plant. •

Elazac Process Test Work is continuing using Bamboo Creek Tails and Mt Webber iron ore fines.
